Online Self-Paced Post Licensing

Provisional Brokers must complete an additional 90 hours of Post Licensing courses, 301, 302, & 303, within 18 months from initial licensure to obtain a full NC Broker license. Students must already be licensed before they may enroll in post-licensing courses. The North Carolina Real Estate Commission will not grant post-licensing credit to students who started post-licensing courses before they received their real estate license.



SC: Mandatory Continuing Education Courses

Associate and Broker licensees with an expiration date of June 30 must complete 6 hours of Electives and 4 hours of mandatory Core continuing education courses to enable them to renew their credentials.



Core: 2024- 2026 Courses

Brokers-in-Charge licensees must complete a mandatory 4-hour Broker-in-Charge, 4 hours of Core, and 2hour Elective continuing education courses to enable them to renew their credentials.
